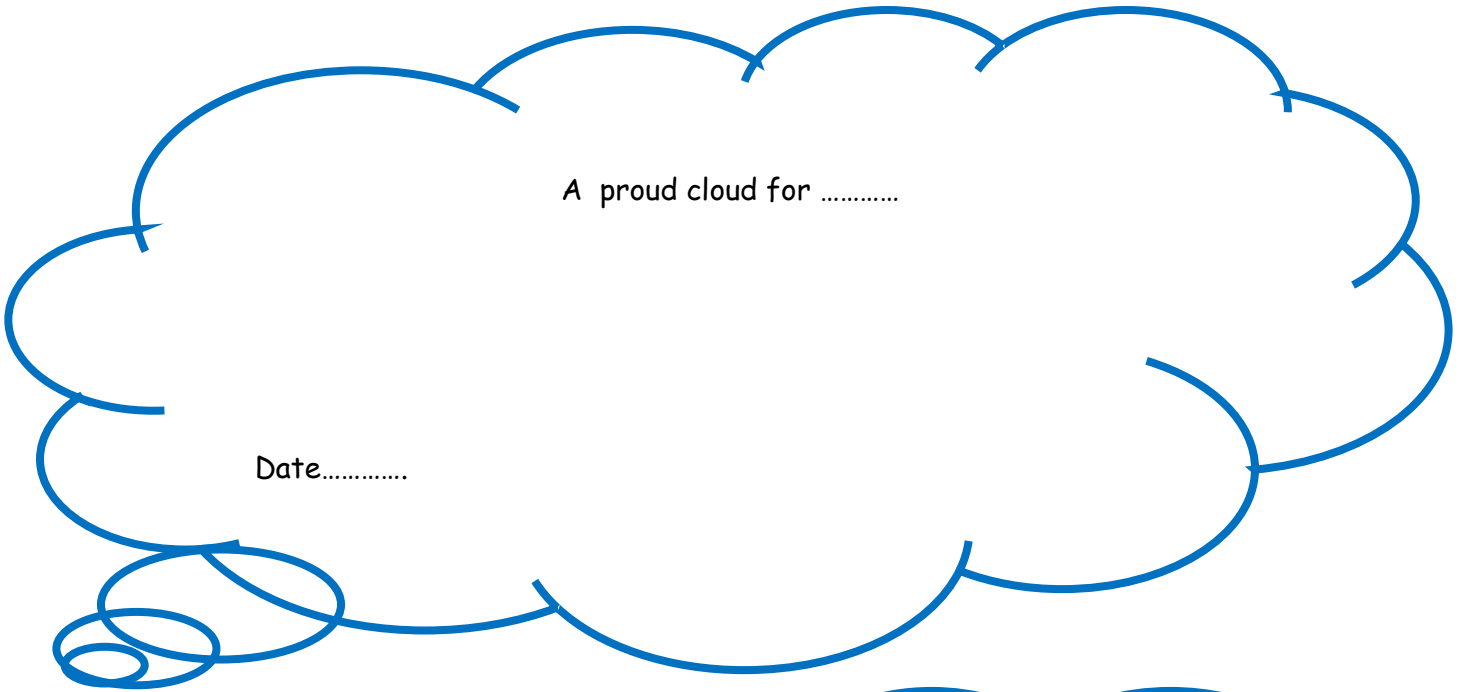

We hope you enjoy the rest of the week and look forward to the sunshine making an appearance!

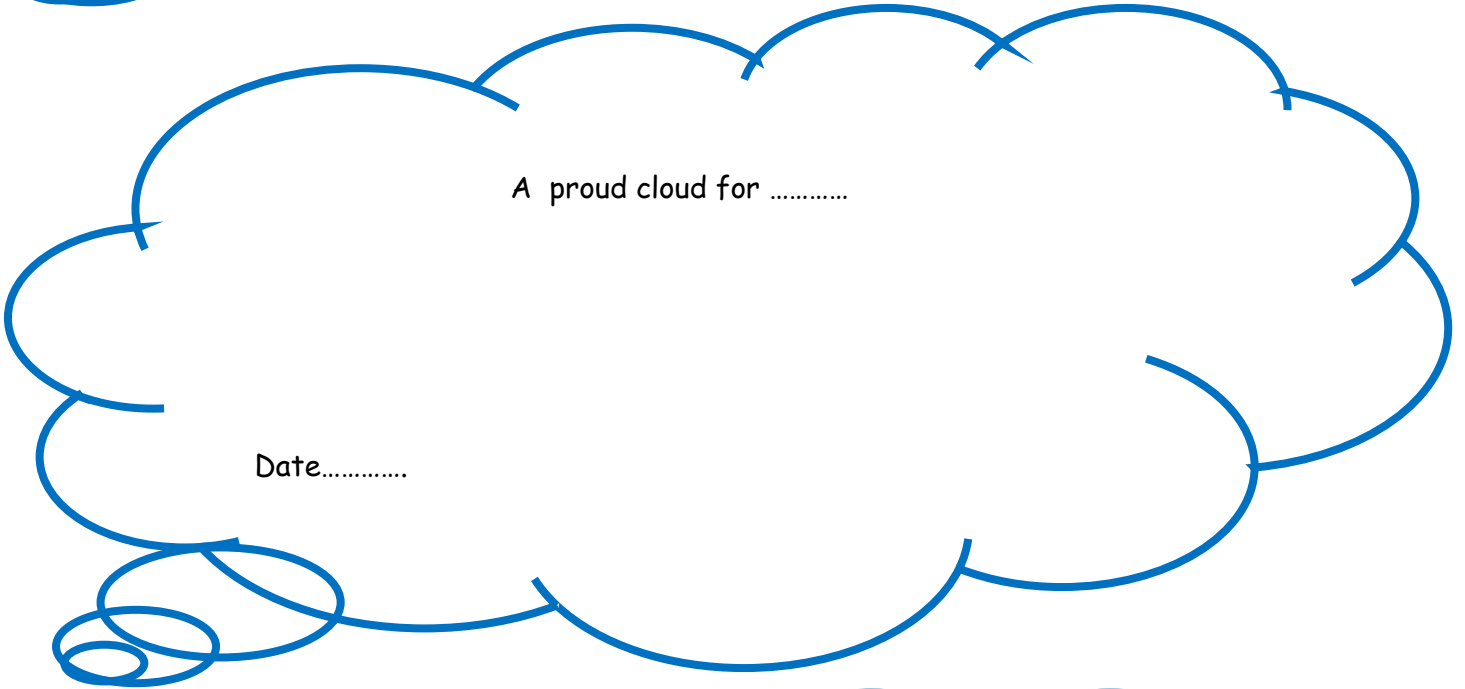

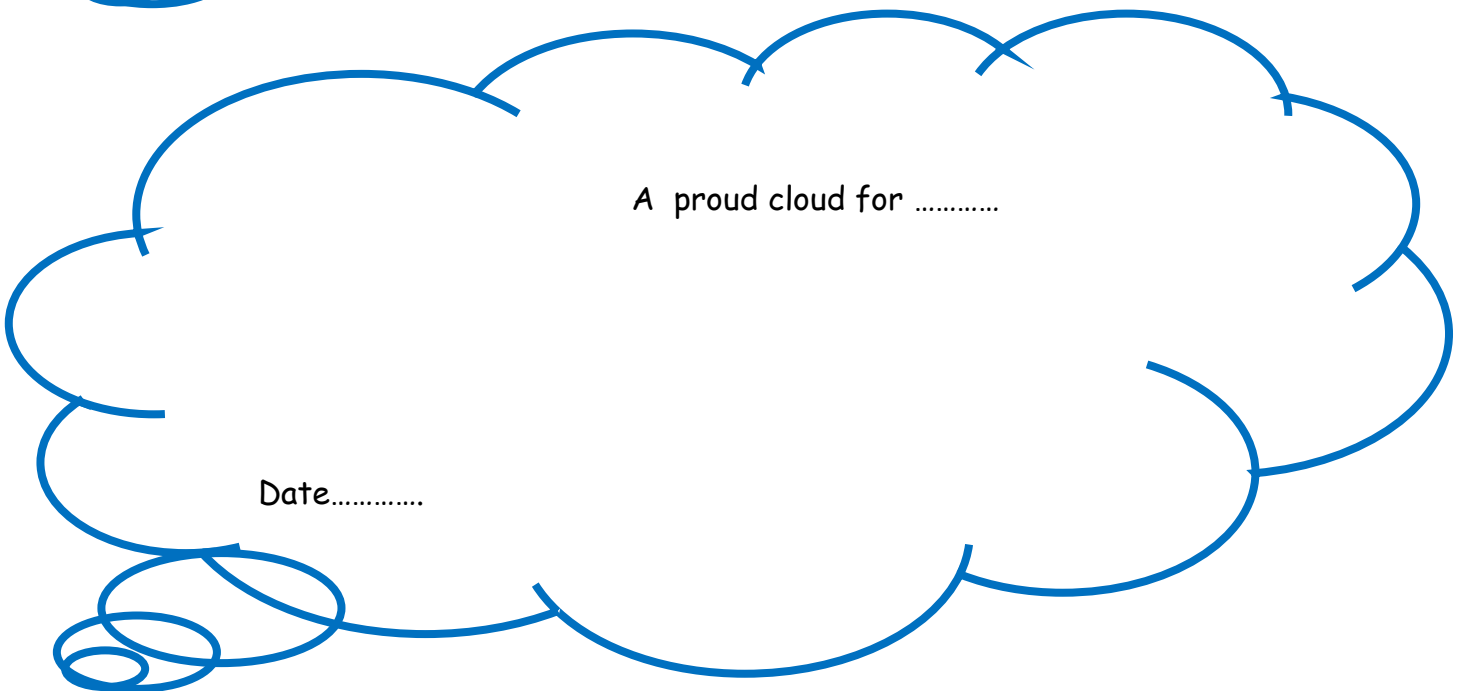
