Culmington Manor Residential 4th -8th June 2018

Dear Y6 Parents,

29th November 2017

Thank you to those of you who were able to attend the meeting concerning the proposed residential. I hope this letter will fill in any gaps for those of you who could not come along and will provide confirmation for those who attended.

Listed below are the key points and information:

General/Security

- The date of the Year 6 residential is 4th-8th June 2018. We feel that the skills of independence and confidence, which can be acquired from such a focus will be most useful to our children.
- Following on from successful visits enjoyed by our Year 6 children, our venue for our residential trip next year will again be "Culmington Manor" (part of the Manor Adventure group) in Shropshire. The website for this venue can be found at www.manoradventure.com.
- The trip will be led by Miss Limberger and other members of staff will attend.
- This trip enables us to fully cover the KS2 curriculum in terms of Outdoor and Adventurous Activities (PE) and some aspects of the geography curriculum.
- If your child receives Pupil Premium Funding this will enable them to participate in all school activities. Your child's Pupil Premium funding will cover the cost of all activities on the trip, however does not cover accommodation and food.
- School staff are on duty throughout the night and centre staff are on call in the event of an emergency.

Cost

The trip will include accommodation, full board and activities at Culmington Manor and coach transport to and from the centre. The total cost of the visit will be approximately **£430-£440** per child depending on how many children attend. If the number of children taking up the visit is reduced the overall cost per child will increase proportionately.

Further details:

- This cost covers: Residential (food, lodging, activities equipment, specialist teaching), coach travel and insurance.
- Payment schedule: **£55** deposit by **Monday 11th December** and then 5 monthly payments of **£75** payable on 1st February, 1st March, 1st April, 1st May and 1st June 2018.
- Pupil Premium payment schedule: **£25** deposit by **Monday 11th December** and then 5 monthly payments of **£38** payable on 1st February, 1st March, 1st April, 1st May and 1st June 2018
- Please email trips@warfieldprimary.co.uk to confirm if your child will be attending this residential trip and confirm that you have paid your deposit via ParentPay. If you have not yet set up your account and need your activation code please contact the school office. We will assess the viability of the trip once we have a firm idea of numbers. Low uptake may mean the trip will have to be cancelled. Please also email to confirm if your child WILL NOT be attending.
- We will confirm final cost when we know numbers and will then make an adjustment on ParentPay

We appreciate that the cost is significant but we have endeavoured to spread the payments and to take out January as it is an expensive time of year. This is a wonderful residential and an excellent learning experience; we very much hope that you would like your child to be part of the trip. If you have any queries, please do not hesitate to contact us. Also, if you would like to discuss any points regarding payment please let us know as we can aim to be flexible and make arrangements to suit most people; but what we do need is to be aware of what you would like to do.
