Dear Parents/Carers,

This week in nursery we have been learning about Autumn. We have enjoyed some lovely Autumn walks, collecting fallen autumnal foliage and taken pictures of trees from different angles including looking up to the sky! The children have also been learning to sort and count the items we had found on our walks labelling the amount with the correct numeral.

We have been using Autumnal colours to paint the leaves and print with them to make patterns and using the leaves to make small animals all ready for our Autumnal display.

We have been continuing to learn the Creation story from the Christian Bible and building our Creation display by making the earth depicting the water and land.

Next week we will be learning about Harvest and what this means to us. We will be learning a harvest song and learning the story of Handa's Surprise by Eileen Browne. On Friday the 6th October the All Saints nursery children will be joining the Harvest worship in the school hall. Woodhurst nursery will join in with the Harvest worship on Monday the 9th October. These are both open worship assemblies where parents are welcome to join the school worship celebrations. If your child usually attends during these sessions your child will be participating towards the end of the worship time. Children who do not usually attend a nursery session on these days do not need to attend. Please speak to a member of the nursery team if you are unsure of these arrangements.

If you would like to donate to our Harvest Worship we will be collecting donations for the Bracknell Foodbank. This year the Food Bank are starting a new initiative COIN A CAN.: they are asking people to donate a tin of food topped with a pound coin (sellotaped on) to help with the cost of storage.

Suggested items are: Tinned Meat, Fish, Rice Pudding, Fruit and Tomatoes.

Pasta Sauce, Long Grain Rice, Sponge Pudding, Custard (Tinned or Packet), Long Life Milk, Long Life Fruit Juice, Potatoes (Tinned or Dried), Tinned Vegetables, Cereal, Jam, Tea Bags, Coffee.

Items not required due to high stocks are baked beans, soup and biscuits.
